1. Socks Puppet:

ACTIVITIES TO BE DONE DURING SUMMER VACATIONS

 4. Feeling of empty bucket with a bowl from a bucket full of water:

5. Stepping up and down the stairs:

Tell your child step up the stairs counting each step "one...two...three.." once the top is reached count backwards "ten..nine...eight.."Keep step up and step down the stair until the energetic child going to adapt at counting. It might take only a few minutes or it might take a few days. There's no rush.
